Residential Warranty

30 Year Residential Product Warranty

Amtico International (hereinafter referred to as 'the Company'), hereby guarantees that in the event of the Amtico Form flooring supplied under this agreement, requiring replacement due to 'wearout' from normal floor traffic within 30 years from the date of purchase, the floor will be repaired or replaced with the same or similar material free of charge. 'Wear-out' means the removal of the pattern and colour from the Amtico Form floor caused by the removal of the protective wear layer.

Please note any other claim in respect of alleged manufacture defects must be notified to us within 6 months of the product being installed otherwise any such claim will be treated as having been waived.

The floor must have been installed in accordance with our installation instructions and the registration process completed by either registering online, sending an e-mail, or completing a registration form.

This Warranty is Conditional on the Following:

1. That the Amtico Form floor has been professionally installed by a qualified installer
2. Qualified installer status is where an installer has attained a National Vocational Qualification in Luxury Vinyl Tile flooring installation at Level 2 or above
3. That the Amtico Form floor has been installed in accordance with the directions contained within the Technical information which can be viewed on our website (www.amtico.com) and BS8203 (the standard for installation of resilient flooring) and using Amtico approved adhesives
4. That the floor is used domestically and has been regularly maintained, using approved products, following current guidelines
5. That precautions have been taken to prevent indentation from heavy point loading (e.g. furniture) and excess surface scratching

Warranty Exclusions:

- Damage caused by stains and spillages, burns, indentation, floods and any other accidents. This includes damage from asphalt, battery acid, bleach or similar corrosives
- Improper care due to the use of incorrect maintenance products, as well as any reduction in surface gloss due to normal wear and tear
- Scratching and scuff marks
- Damage caused by objects being dropped or dragged across the floor
- Flooring problems caused by improper installation including the incorrect use of non-recommended adhesives, floor preparation materials, underfloor heating or improper subfloor preparation. Also damage caused by the presence of moisture, alkaline substances or fluid pressure from the subfloor over which the floor is laid
- Damage or fading caused by exposure to sunlight or excessive heat
- Use of the floor in any unheated or outside/external location

NOTE: Avoid the use of rubber or latex backed mats, as some types can cause permanent floor discolouration.

This Warranty is the only guarantee given to the user by the company and does not warrant the Amtico Form flooring supplied to be fit for a particular purpose or use. It is the responsibility of the user or user's agents to ensure that the Amtico Form floor is suitable for purpose.

This Warranty is applicable to the Amtico Form range of products purchased through approved Amtico flooring specialists and installed within the UK.

Samples distributed prior to the selection and installation of the floor may be from varying batches. Decoration and shading may vary to the final material used in the installation.

Using and Maintaining your Warranty

In the unlikely event of any claim under this warranty, please write to the AfterCare Technical Services Department, Amtico International, Kingfield Road, Coventry, CV6 5AA or telephone 024 7686 1409. If examination shows that the floor has been installed and maintained as specified, the company will repair or replace the flooring with the same or similar material free of charge.

Transferable Warranty

The warranty is transferable and should you move house, the warranty will remain with the floor you have purchased i.e. floor warranty is for the property, not the purchaser.

This warranty does not affect your statutory rights.
