

Gender Pay Gap Reporting 2017

Amtico is required by law to publish an annual gender pay gap report.

This is its report for the snapshot date of 5 April 2017.

The mean gender pay gap is: 8.38%
The median gender pay gap is: -1.25%
The mean gender bonus gap is: 66.82%
The median gender bonus gap is: 52.41%

The proportion of males receiving a bonus is 46% and the proportion of females receiving a bonus is 83%

Band	Males	Females	Description
A	75%	25%	Includes all employees whose standard hourly rate places them at or below the lower quartile.
B	75%	25%	Includes all employees whose standard hourly rate places them above the lower quartile but at or below the median.
C	69%	31%	Includes all employees whose standard hourly rate places them above the median but at or below the upper quartile.
D	74%	26%	Includes all employees whose standard hourly rate places them above the upper quartile.

Amtico's workforce consists of 73% males and 27% females.

The figures set out above have been calculated using the standard methodologies used in the Equality Act 2010 (Gender Pay Gap Information)
